

As a member of the Elite Athlete Education Network (EAEN), The University of Newcastle is committed to supporting elite student athletes to achieve academic and sporting excellence. The University of Newcastle provides elite student athletes with access to sport and academic scholarships, access to premier sporting facilities and opportunities to represent The University of Newcastle in sport.

You may be considered for an ATAR adjustment up to 4 points should you be recognised as an Elite Athlete as a school leaver or University applicant.

An application for Elite Athlete Status must be submitted no later than 31 October (or for mid-year applicants by 30 June) and should the application be successful, confirmation of status as an Elite Athlete will be provided to the University of Newcastle admissions team.

The Elite Athletes, Performers and Leaders (EAPL) Program considers both academic and elite extra-curricular achievements and recognises these by awarding adjustment factors. Activities must have been undertaken in Years 11 and/or 12.
